

WRITE TO A PERSON WHO MADE MY CLOTHES

AGE

7-11

MATERIALS

- Paper
- Art materials,
- Pens and highlighters

AIMS

The students think about a person who might have made their favourite item of clothing and write a postcard to them.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Ask them to imagine a person who might have sewn this item together in a factory or helped to grow or make its materials
- Ask them what they would say to that person if they had the chance
- Ask them to write a postcard to that person
- Ask them to draw a picture of the item of clothing that they are talking about on the reverse side, making sure to write its brand name and/or draw its logo
- Ask them to read out what they have written to the class
- Add their postcards to your Fashion Revolution Week display
- Photograph the postcards and send them to the brands via email or social media using [#whomademyclothes](https://www.instagram.com/whomademyclothes) or send them by mail.
